What's Happening

September is National Suicide Prevention Month. For our monthly support meeting we hosted Stephanie D., Associate Executive Director from Suicide Prevention Services. Stephanie spoke about the signs associated with suicidal ideation and talked about how we can support those who may be struggling. Nearly half (49%) of LGBTQ+ young people ages 13-17 experienced bullying in the past year, and those who did reported significantly higher rates attempting suicide in the past year than those who did not experience bullying. It was a beneficial conversation for all. In addition to our support meeting, I was able to attend a "Teacups for Trevor Project" fundraising event hosted by the Sycamore United Methodist Church. Having just one accepting adult in a young LGBTQIA+ person's life reduces their risk of a suicide attempt by 24%. There was a statement made at that event by one of the cochairs of the Pride Group at SUMC that by being at the event was suicide prevention. If being an accepting adult can reduce young people's risk by 24%, imagine what could happen if there are more accepting adults in their lives!!!



Our chapter was also able to participate in a few other events this past month. Elaine and I attended a Beyond the Blond summer concert in South Elgin where we were able to get our message out to the attendees. Jen and Elaine also participate in a resource table with PFLAG DuPage for Naper Pride.
