He has since become a leading figure in LGBTQ+ organizations across the Midwest and now continues his advocacy work in California.
 - Samuel is a passionate advocate and outspoken opponent of conversion therapy. Through social media and community engagement, he raises awareness, holds practitioners accountable, and shares his lived experience as a survivor.  - This meeting WILL BE Hybrid, in person and available on Zoom.

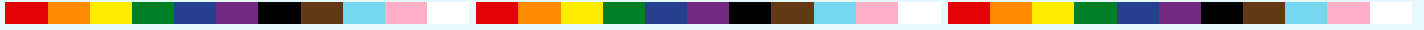
Our monthly meetings take place on the second Monday of each month from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m.

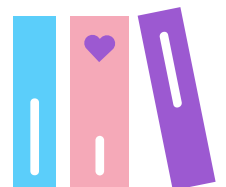


About the Author

Nico Lang (they/them) is a nonbinary award-winning journalist with over a decade of experience covering the transgender community's fight for equality. Their work has appeared in major publications, including Rolling Stone, Esquire, The New York Times, Vox, The Wall Street Journal, Salon, Harper's Bazaar, Time, The Washington Post, and the Los Angeles Times. Lang is the creator of Queer News Daily and previously served as the deputy editor for Out magazine, the news editor for Them, the LGBTQ+ correspondent for VICE, and the editor and cofounder of the literary journal In Our Words.

Their industry-leading contributions to queer media have resulted in a GLAAD Media Award, 10 awards from the National Association of LGBTQ Journalists (NLGJA), and three awards from the Los Angeles Press Club, including the 2023 Online Journalist of the Year.

Lang is also the first-ever recipient of the Visibility Award from the Transgender Legal Defense and Education Fund (TLDEF), an honor created to recognize their impactful contributions to reporting on the lives of LGBTQ+ people.

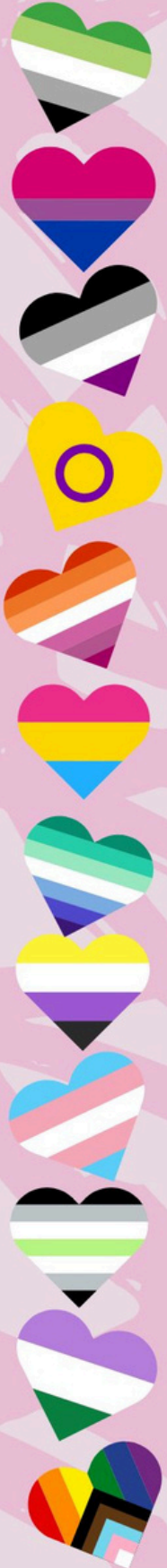

“There is one force that powers PFLAG. It is not a building. It is not a budget. It is not a logo or a brand. **It is our volunteers.**”

Without volunteers, PFLAG would not exist. Not locally. Not nationally. Not anywhere.

Volunteers open the doors at chapter meetings and make sure the lights are on. They welcome new parents who arrive anxious and unsure, and they help them leave with hope.

They staff tables at community events and art festivals. They answer hard questions.

They **educate gently**. They **advocate firmly**.

They show up – again and again – even when it's raining, even when it's uncomfortable, even when the work feels heavy.” - Andrew Zanevsky
